RE: OXYGENICS SHOWERHEADS AND THE LEGACY HOTEL GROUP

It is with pleasure that I write to you regarding the Oxygenics water and power-saving showerheads that you have supplied to the Legacy Hotel Group.

Following successful performance testing of the SkinCare Showerhead (ETL code # 60120), we installed these units in a number of our hotels and lodges, as a pilot project.
